
The last few months of 2024 are upon us, and it seems like this year is flying by!

## HISTORY

## THE INSTALLATION OF PRINCE LEOPOLD OF ALBANY IN ANTIQUITY #2 IN LONDON

The installation of Prince Leopold of Albany as Worshipful Master of Antiquity Lodge #2 in London was guite the news of the day according to the London Times of July 1876. Antiquity Lodge #2 is reported to be one of the oldest lodges in England. The lodge boasts some of the brightest names in history as enthusiastic members of the order. It was presided over by Sir Christopher Wren, great architect, who planned the many magnificent edifices erected after the devasting fire of London in 1666. William III was initiated in this lodge, and it had for master for thirty-four years the Duke of Sussex, the great uncle of Prince Leopold. Among its archives is the gavel used by Charles II to lay the foundation stone of St. Paul's Cathedral and a fragment of the Roman Temple that once stood where St. Paul's now stands. Among the Englishmen who were Masons are Cardinal Wolsey, Lord Bacon, Newton, Shakespeare and Dr. Oliver(?) even places with its patrons commencing with Augustin the Monk in A.D, 597, King Alfred, King Athelstan, Edward the Confessor, Henry I, Edward III, Henry VII, James I and Charles I. In Prussia, Frederick the Great was head of the order, and his example was followed by the present Emperor of Germany and the Crown Prince. Literary greats such as Gotthold E Lessing, Johann G Herder, Johann Fichte and Johann Wolfgang von Goethe have exemplified the teachings of the order.

Notwithstanding the thunder of the Vatican, Masonry flourishes in most the Catholic countries of the globe. In France there at 287 lodges; in Spain 800; in Portugal 22; in Italy 110; in Belgium 15; in Mexico 18, and in Brazil 265. In Protestant Countries the United States stands first with 10,000 lodges and in England second with 2000. In Russia those in authority have ever endeavored to suppress the order as being too liberal and tolerant to the Jews, who are ever the best Masons. A letter from Hierophant Olcott of Madame Blavatsky's Theosophical Society (*I encourage you to look this one up*), says Masonry is contributing to the breaking down of the caste system in priest-ridden India. In the eyes of this order, the Pariah (*Masonry*) is on a *level* with the Rajput (*look this one up too, it is the upper ruling warrior class of India*).

Editor Notes:

Prince Leopold served as Master of the lodge from 1876 to 1877 and was later the Provincial Grand Master for Oxfordshire, holding that office until his death. In 1882 he laid the foundation stone of the Masonic Hall on Marlborough Street in Banbury.

Antiquity Lodge meets in London and is one of the four lodges that formed the Premier Grand Lodges in 1717. Other illustrious brethren included William Preston who led the lodge in a rebellion against the Modern Grand Lodge and established the Grand Lodge of All England South of the river Trent. This lasted about ten years, and the lodge of Antiquity returned to the fold.




